	Crabbs Green Battery Unit <ul style="list-style-type: none">Catherine Armstrong has advised that the tree clearance is wide enough to take a lorry at the edge of the nature reserve.To be verified but it is thought Samatha Russell owns the land & it seems that is where the clearance has started.Quite a substantial area, it isn't clear why this is being done.Substation is expanding, more equipment is being added.Jo Van Reimsdijk is still in contact with Environmental Health, East Herts Environmental Health have investigated noise levels from the existing battery unit and have consequently recommended refusal of the application due to insufficient noise attenuation.
